SCHENGEN VISA

During your tour with Dramart Productions you may be visiting various countries including Spain, France, Italy and Greece. Specific countries will vary depending on the course you have chosen and the coach routing..

Some of these countries are members of the **Schengen Agreement**. Countries participating in the Schengen Agreement are listed below. Because the coach may be leaving and re-entering countries which participate in the Schengen Agreement, certain nationalities will be required to obtain a **Multiple-Entry Schengen Visa** (for at least two entries) prior to starting your tour. A Multiple-Entry Schengen Visa may be required if your passport has been issued by a country other than the United States, Canada or European Community. If you hold a British Citizen Passport, you will not be required to obtain a Schengen Visa.

Visa requirements vary depending on the passport under which you are travelling and the countries being visited. Passengers travelling under non-US, non-Canadian and non-European passports must check with the Consulate of every country visited during the tour for specific visa requirements. When contacting the Consulate for the country being visited, be sure to provide the complete itinerary of the tour so the Consulate can provide the correct information as to the Schengen Visa requirements. Passengers may also contact a visa service agency in their own country for assistance.

If a Schengen Visa is required for your nationality and you are not in possession of this visa when departing for the tour, you may be denied entry OR in Schengen Agreement ports the local authorities may detain you and charge you a penalty fee.

SCHENGEN VISA: Summary

1. There are 15 countries that are part of the Schengen Agreement: Austria, Belgium, Denmark, France, Finland, Germany, Greece, Iceland, Italy, Luxembourg, the Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Spain and Sweden.
2. Non-Schengen countries include: Estonia, Russia, Poland, Turkey
3. If a non-Schengen country is visited in-between visits to Schengen countries, a **Multiple-Entry Schengen Visa** will be required.
4. The UK is not a Schengen Member State - United Kingdom Passport holders do not require a Schengen Visa
5. Passengers must show proof of medical insurance coverage of at least U.S. \$45,000 in order to obtain a **Multiple-Entry Schengen Visa**. Additionally, this proof of medical insurance coverage is also required when entering a Schengen Visa country.
6. Currently U.S., Canadian, and European Community passport holders do not require a Schengen Visa.
7. The following are a few types of passports requiring a **Multiple-Entry Schengen Visa**: passports issued by Russia; Trinidad & Tobago; Colombia; China; Morocco; Hong Kong; Philippines; Turkey. Please contact a Schengen Country Consulate for a complete list.
